### PLEASE NOTE

*In the interest of your comfort and enjoyment, the following requirements are to be observed by members or their guests when visiting the club.*

## COURSE MARSHALL

### (When Available)

The Course Marshall is appointed by the Match and Greens in consultation with the Club Captain and General Manager with the aim of ensuring that all members and visitors are able to gain maximum enjoyment in playing their game of golf.

### THE COURSE MARSHALL AND GOLF SHOP STAFF:

- has right-of-way on the course at all times.
- has the authority of the Match Officials in recommending penalties for slow play.
- has the authority of the Club to eject persons from the course for unacceptable conduct or dress.
- has the authority to remove equipment (carts, hire clubs, etc) from persons misusing such equipment.
- can provide advice but not rulings on matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf, the Local Rules of the club or the competition of the day. Such rulings must be referred to the Match and Greens.

Members and visitors are asked to assist the Course Marshall in the conduct of their duties by adhering to their advice, complying with any instructions they issue, and providing them with any possible assistance.

## LOCAL RULES

### OUT OF BOUNDS

All areas outside the club boundary fences. The club house, car park, practice putting green, pro shop and the connecting paths.

### ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITION

Ground Under Repair marked by a sign, rope, white lines or pegs, formed gardens, staked trees and ornamental shrubs under two club lengths, bare patches on fairways are no play zones and relief is to be taken in accordance with rule 16.

### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION

Signs on the golf course, hazard and distance pegs, sprinkler heads, roads, paths, the communication tower and grounds surrounded by the fence near the 4th green are immovable obstructions and relief is available in accordance with rule 16.

### SPRINKLER HEAD NEAR PUTTING GREEN

If a sprinkler head within 2 club lengths of the green and within 2 club lengths of the ball intervenes with the line of play between the ball and the hole, relief may be taken.

### BALL PLAYED FROM 10TH TEE

A ball played from the 10th tee which lands on the first fairway must be replayed without penalty.

### PRIVATE PROPERTY

Players must report all incidents when a ball hits private property.

### MOTORISED CARTS

Motorised carts must be kept 15 meters away from the greens, GUR areas and damp areas on the course.

### PRACTICE AREA

Practice with irons only to temp green behind putting practice area or the old 8th hole near members 10th tee only. Under no circumstances will practice be permitted towards or on the greens of the course.

# UPKEEPING THE COURSE

The following points are provided to assist in the upkeep of the course and promote proper etiquette so that you and your fellow members have an enjoyable round of golf.

## REPAIRING BALL MARKS

1. Always start at the back of the mark and push forward with the repairer.
2. Use repairer around all sides and slowly ease turf toward the centre of the mark. Do not lift the soil upwards.
3. Lightly tap down with putter.
4. Your completed repairs should look like the images below.

## REPAIRING DIVOTS

1. Remove any loose turf from the affected area.
2. Knock on all sides of the edge on the divot with your club or your shoe.

3. Correct mended divot.
4. Use the sand from the bucket you are carrying to complete the repair.

## DAMAGE TO GREENS

### Flagsticks, Bags etc.

Players and caddies should ensure they cause no damage to the green when putting down bags or the flagstick. They should not stand too close to the hole when handling the flagstick or removing the ball. Replace the flagstick on leaving the green.

1. Don't drop the flagstick on the putting surface as it will cause damage.

2. Always lower the flagstick by club or by hand.
3. Avoid damage to surrounds by placing the stick in the centre of the cup.

## BUNKERS

Before leaving a bunker, a player should carefully fill up and smooth over all holes and footprints, and leave the rake with the handle pointing toward the tee or the hole being played.

1. Always enter the bunker at the lowest point.
2. Pull rake toward you as you exit the bunker.
3. If required, rake other affected areas.
4. Do not pile sand at the edge of the bunker. Push back excess sand.
5. Do not rake the face of the bunker. Smoother out with the back of the rake.

## MOTORISED GOLF CARTS, MOTOR CYCLES & BATTERY POWERED GOLF TROLLEYS

1. None of these vehicles are to be taken between bunkers and putting surfaces or onto any teeing ground.
2. Motorised golf carts and motor cycles are not to be taken within the coloured perimeter lines marked on fairways in proximity to putting greens.
3. Players using any of the above vehicles have no special priorities and must maintain their position in the field.
4. Players using any of the above vehicles are bound by any rules laid down by the Club pertaining to the use of such vehicles.



## COURSE DRESS REGULATIONS

A Collared shirt (Golf Specific Collarless Shirts Allowed), tailored trousers or shorts, long socks or sport socks. Members are requested to set the standard required of visitors.

### HOUSE DRESS REGULATIONS

Members and visitors must be neat and tidy in appearance. NO hats or spikes to be worn inside the clubhouse. 'Working apparel is not permitted on weekends.' Persons not complying with these rules may be refused service and asked to leave the premises.

### CLUB RULES

Members shall observe proper dress and orderly conduct within the clubhouse. Members introducing visitors must ensure that required details are entered in the Visitors Register. All complaints should be made in writing and conveyed to the General Manager. In no instance shall an employee of the club be directly reprimanded by a member.

### COURSE RULES

#### THE COURSE STAFF HAVE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES

Members and visitors are requested to assist the course staff in the proper maintenance of the course by:

- Carrying and using the sand buckets provided
- Repairing all divot holes
- Repairing lob marks on greens
- Using bins provided for disposal of rubbish.

### MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones allowable with discretion, constant use is frowned upon.

### MATCH OFFICIALS

Shall consist of a minimum of two members of the Match and Greens preferably the Club Captain and one other.

**Handicap:** All requests for Handicap adjustment due to injury or illness must be submitted to Match and Greens in writing for consideration.

**Tee Times:** Members should be available to collect their cards 15 minutes before the booked tee time.

**Booking Sheet:** Members wishing to cancel a booked time must notify the Golf Shop staff at least 24 hours prior to the booking. Failure to observe this requirement may result in the fee for the missed competition being charged to the member(s), and payable before any further booked times are permitted.

**Before Play:** Members should read any notices regarding local rules or notices relating to the play of competition. Handicaps may be checked on the Member accessible terminal situated in the clubhouse.

**Score Cards:** The rules of golf place the onus on the competitor to see that his correct score is recorded by his marker for each hole. The score must be recorded by his marker at the completion of each hole. The practice of writing up cards in the clubhouse is not permitted. The competitor must (1) ensure that the marker has signed the card; (2) countersign the card himself; (3) record score in slice terminals upstairs in club house; (4) place the card in the competition box in the Clubhouse. Any alteration on the card must be initialled by the marker. For any failure to observe these requirements penalties

as provided for in the Rules of Golf will be applied. Members shall be responsible for showing all scores, and totalling all scores on competition cards.

**Ties In Competitions:** In match play, if players square the match after the stipulated holes per round, or rounds, they shall continue to play, and the match shall be won by the player or players who first win another hole.

In the event of two or more players returning the same or equal in a stroke, par or stableford competition, the winner will be decided by a count-back, excepting in the 72 holes Stroke, Club Championships, B & C Grade Championships, Wallacia Cup, Medal of Medals, Mixed Foursomes Championships, Foursomes Championships, Veterans Championships and Mixed Veterans Championships.

In the event of a tie in the Wallacia Cup, Club Championships, B & C Grade Championships, Junior Championships, Foursomes Championships, Veterans Championships and Mixed Veterans Championships, a play off over three holes immediately following completion of the normal competition round(s) will be played to decide the winner, and if necessary "Sudden Death" thereafter.

In the event of a tie on Medal Round or Medal of Medals, all play off's will be decided over 18 holes the winner will be the person with the best net score on the next Medal Round. Match and Greens may alter play off criteria to meet specific circumstances.

### ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF

The player on the lowest handicap shall be responsible for the proper observance of the etiquette of golf, particularly in regard to SLOW PLAY, and Rules 5 & 6 hereunder. Should

two or more players be equally handicapped they shall mutually arrange responsibility.

1. No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or playing a stroke.
2. The player who has the honour should be allowed to play before his opponent or fellow competitor tees his ball. In some circumstances the player who has the honour may relinquish the right to play first in the interest of the speed of play!
3. No player should play until the players in front are out of range.
4. Slow play is NOT permitted! Penalties for slow play are; first offence , warning second offence (1) stroke. Third offence is disqualification and suspension.
5. Players searching for a lost ball should signal the players behind them to pass as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found; they should not search for three minutes before doing so. They should not continue to play until the players following them have passed and are out of range.
6. Before leaving a bunker, a player should carefully rake up all footprints and holes made by him.
7. Through the green a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him is replaced at once and pressed down. Sand buckets are provided for the use of all players. Any damage to the putting green made by the ball or the player is to be repaired carefully.
8. When the play of the hole is completed players should immediately leave the putting green. Do not delay teeing off on the following hole in order to mark cards; the player with the honour should immediately step up to the tee, and complete the card after his tee shot.



**REMEMBER:** it is the duty of every member to preserve the reputation of the Club by:

- (a) maintaining the spirit of good fellowship between himself and every other member.
- (b) extending the hand of welcome to all visitors.
- (c) placing all empty cans and rubbish in the bins provided for that purpose.
- (d) NO glass permitted on the Golf Course at any time
- (e) NO takeaway alcohol to be brought onto Course (must be purchased in Club House)

### PROTESTS

Any competitor desiring to enter a protest in connection with a match or competition shall do so verbally and then in writing, addressed to the Match Officials, who shall consider such protest and whose decision will be final. Protests must be entered immediately on completion of the match or competition. The Match Officials will inform the writer of their decision.

### MIXED FOURSOMES

In the Mixed Foursomes Championship men will play from the first tee, ladies from the second tee, and alternate tees thereafter.

### MEN'S FOURSOMES

In the Men's Foursome Championship, Members will play from alternate tees in the first 18 holes. The order of play will reverse for the next 9 holes.

### GENERAL

The Captain shall have the right of the course at any time should they wish to exercise that privilege. In competitions extending over more than one round, players will play off the handicap at the commencement of the competition, that handicap will apply for aggregate scores. The handicap rules will apply for individual rounds.

### SUMMARY OF EVENT TYPES

**Stroke:** Players count the shots taken to hole the ball. Handicaps are deducted from the total score at the end of the game.



**NOTE:** All C Grade (Handicap 19 and above) players will play from the forward tee (blue/white) on the 5th hole during all individual stroke competitions.

**2BBB Stroke:** As for Stroke except that handicap shots are taken at the appropriate holes to determine the team score (the better of the two) for the hole.

**Hijack:** As for 2BBB Stroke except that the team score is the best stroke score for the first 6 holes, the worst stroke score for the second 6 holes, and the sum of the partners stroke scores for the last 6 holes.

**Stableford:** Points are awarded based on handicap on each hole - a par, after handicap, gaining two points. Each shot under handicap gains an additional point, each shot over handicap loses a point. The minimum score on a hole is zero points. The Index on the scorecard is used to determine how many handicap shots a player gets on a hole.

**2BBB Stableford:** As for Stableford, but as a team. The best Stableford score for each two player team counts as the team score on each hole.

**2BWB Stableford:** As for 2BBB Stableford, except the worst score of the two team members counts as the team score on each hole.

**Aggregate Stableford:** As for Stableford for each player, the team score being the total of the individual players scores on each hole.

**Stableford Multiplier:** As for Aggregate Stableford, except that the points of the two players are multiplied rather than added.

**Ransom:** As for Stableford, but with the team score being determined by the best score for the first 6 holes, the aggregate (sum total) score for the second six holes, and the multiplied scores of the players for the last six holes.

**Irish Stableford:** Team event for 4 players, each scoring as in individual Stableford. For the first 6 holes the team score is the best score in the group. For holes 7 to 12 the team score is the sum of the two best scores in the group. For the last 6 holes the team score is the sum of the best three scores in the group.

**Par:** As for Stableford, except a nett par scores a square or zero. Less than nett par scores a plus (+), over nett par scores a minus (-).

**Par Bonus:** As for Stableford, 1 point or less scores a minus(-), 2 points scores a square or zero, 3 points scores a plus (+), 4 points scores a double plus (++), 5 points scores a triple plus (+++).

**2BBB Par Bonus:** As for Par Bonus, with the better score of each partner being the team score for each hole.

**Aggregate Par:** As for Par Bonus, but with the sum of the two players scores being the team score for each hole.

**Par Bisque:** As for Par except that the player is able to allocate handicap strokes as desired over the course. This must be done at the completion of the each hole.

**Foursomes:** Players take turns hitting the one ball until it is holed. Players take alternate tee shots. Handicap is ½ of the Aggregate Handicap.

**Canadian Foursomes:** As for Foursomes except both players tee off - then select one of these balls and play alternately until it is holed. The player whose ball is not selected plays the second shot. Handicap is 3/8 of the Aggregate Handicap.

**American Foursomes:** As for Canadian Foursomes except that after playing their tee shot, each player then hits their partners ball before deciding which ball shall become the one to play out the hole. Handicap is 3/8 of the Aggregate Handicap.

**Ambrose:** In 2, 3 or 4 ball Ambrose each player in the team hits each shot. The team then decides which shot they wish to take and all players then hit from that location. The team handicap is deducted at the end of the round. Handicap is ¼ of the Aggregate Handicap for 2 players, 1/6 of the Aggregate Handicap for 3 players and 1/8 of the Aggregate Handicap for 4 players. 3 tee shots for a team of 4, 4 tee shots for a team of 3 and 6 tee shots for a team of 2.

**Irish Ambrose:** As for Ambrose with the difference that whoever's shot is taken does not get to hit the ball from that position.

# SPECIAL COMPETITIONS

**SUMMER AND WINTER CUPS:** Top 64 Players in the qualifying rounds make up in the Cup field. Stableford Points are awarded for each of the four rounds. The Cup winner is the member with the highest number of points.

## JUNIOR FOUNDATION CUP

Stableford points are awarded for each of the nominated 4 rounds. The cup winner is the member with the highest number of points.

**COCK OF THE WALK:** Best 8 net scores in each grade in the first round of the club championships qualify to compete. Each grade is conducted separately the field is then halved after each round of the Championships. The final two players for each grade play off in the final round of the Championships.

## JACK AND SANDRA PETTETT VETERANS TROPHY:

The best nett score in the August Medal for Mens and Ladies Veterans (over 50)

## HANDICAP MATCHPLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

*(Peterson Cup)*

The best 32 net scores in the nominated round qualify to compete. Players will have approximately three weeks to complete their match with their nominated opponent. Matches can be played in conjunction with the scheduled competition on a day, as long as the rules of the competition are observed. The allocation of shots is according to the match play index (not the normal hole rating), with the number of shots involved determined by the difference in

the handicaps of the two players. For example, a player off a handicap of 4 concedes 6 shots to a player on a handicap of 10. Each player's handicap is their handicap on the day their match is played.

**CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Played in five grades ~ A (handicap 12 or less), B (13 to 18) and C (19 and over), Veterans ~ (over 50), and Juniors as stroke rounds. Juniors and Veterans compete in their relevant grades in addition to the grade competition. The champion in each grade is determined on the basis of scratch score. Players maintain their original handicap throughout the championships ~ but must adjust net scores on their card if their handicap changes for the day competitions.

C Grade (19 and over) play off the forward tee (blue/white)

on the 5th hole. If the player is in C Grade for round 1, they play from the forward tee for ALL rounds of the championship regardless of any handicap changes during the championship rounds. B Grade (13 to 18). If you start the championships in B grade, then you tee off from the white markers for ALL rounds of the championship.



### NOTE:

For the final round of the club championships a set time of 9.30 am for the top 8 in A, B and C grades apply.

Players must play at their tee time allocated by the pro shop with a grade hitting off first playing in 2 groups per grade in the order of 5, 6, 7 & 8 followed by 1, 2, 3 & 4.

**FOUNDATION CUP** – This is the Best Nett H'cap 18 holes over the 4 rounds of the club championship, of all grades.

**R. HOSKIN SHIELD** – 36 holes Nett H'cap winner over the 4 rounds of the club championships. Winner is determined by the best 2 scores of their 4 rounds, of all grades.

**H. ROYLANCE TROPHY** – Best 72 holes Nett H'cap winner of all rounds played during the club championships of all grades.

**BLACKBUTT BOWL** – C. Cross Trophy.  
Competition played over 11 medal rounds and 4 rounds of club championship. Winner determined by players playing at least 10 rounds and the best 7 scores determine winner.

## MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Top 8 players from the Club Championship from all grades including Veterans & Juniors qualify to play matchplay. All grades must be played within the designated time frame and the final match to be played over 36 holes.

**EASTER BOWL:** Open Mixed Event

**MULGOA CUP:** Open Mixed Event

**REMEMBRANCE SHIELD:** Open Mixed Event

**ARTHUR AND MABS DOWNES**

**CHRISTMAS HAMS DAY:** This is a Members Only medley four ball Ambrose competition played prior to Christmas.

**WALLACIA WIPEOUT:** An 18-hole knockout competition for 19 players. Players qualify for the event during the 4 Saturdays of the Championships. Qualifiers are selected on the basis of net stroke scores recorded in those competition days. The event has all 19 players play as one group ~ the worst net score being eliminated at each hole. In the event of a tie on any hole a nearest-the-pin chip-off from a pre-determined location will be used to decide who is eliminated. The winner is the only player not eliminated after the full 18 holes.

### ADDITIONAL NOTES

Match and Greens reserves the right to change the event(s) scheduled for any day as circumstances require. Such circumstances may prevent prior notification to members of any changes.

Members are graded on their current handicap as A (12 or less), B (13 to 18), or C (19 or higher) for all relevant competitions unless specifically stated otherwise in the Fixture Book. The Junior Club Championship and Junior Wallacia Cup include an additional Junior Grade which is contested in conjunction with player's handicap grade.

Members are invited to sponsor an event of their choosing. Sponsorship can be arranged to suit almost any budget and can be organised through General Manager or any member of the Match and Greens.

Where playing numbers permit, individual prizes may be awarded in grades for all 2B members competitions, as well as for Ladies in Mixed or Medley 2B competitions.

In 2 Ball teams events all members of the Team must play in the same group.
